

# A Public Realm Strategy for Port Sunlight

## Community Engagement Event

Port Sunlight Village Trust (PSVT) and Wirral Council have commissioned Planit-IE, Urban Designers and Landscape Architects, to develop a public realm strategy for the Village.

The public realm includes all the spaces between the buildings, including the streets, monuments and landscape features, views and vistas, public open spaces, and in Port Sunlight's case the communal spaces at the back of the blocks, the large verges, and front gardens also. The road carriageways and pavements throughout the village are adopted by Wirral Council, a significant area of the public realm, therefore it is important that this piece of work is delivered in partnership with Wirral Council.

The public realm plays a fundamental role in our perception and understanding of places, influencing how we interpret them and the quality of our experience within them. In addition, the public realm plays a crucial role in how well places function and how successful they are in meeting the long-term needs of residents and short-term needs of people just passing through. It is through this realisation and appreciation of the significance of the public realm that PSVT and Wirral Council have identified the need for a public realm strategy.
