	 Assist with visitor orientation around the property.
	 Present the Edwardian Worker's Cottage describing it's history and purpose.
	 Answer general questions about Port Sunlight Village and the work of PSVT.
	 Assist with the management of visitor numbers and flow.
	 Undertake audience research on behalf of PSVT , e.g
	surveys.
	Report an additional cleaning, exhibit maintenance or
	safety issues to visitor services staff.
